


Final Examination : 05/10/2020 to 15/10/2020

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
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
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Details furnished by student teachers while filling the google form for ECE Prgoramme

Freshers Day and Talents Day - 28/11/2020

























In the afternoon session Mr. Jagadeesh discussed with students on the topic "Barriers of Communication". And also he facilitated students in how to write a Report of this workshop.






Micro Teaching Workshop : 14/12/2020 to 18/12/2020

5'E' Transactional skills Workshop

28-12-2020 to 31-12-2020





As per the revised D.EL.Ed syllabus ,the knowledge of Transactional skills is very essential for teacher-trainees. The Institution conducted Orientation on Transactional skills from 28-12-2020 to 31-12-2020 for both first and second year D.EL.Ed Students. The main purpose is to make trainees aware of 5E method of teaching. Sr.Prema.C has taken the incharge of conducting orientation with the co-operation of all the lecturers. The plan of action was prepared and topics were allotted for the lectures according to their specialization and expertise, The orientation was inaugurated on 28/12/2020. Sr.Prema.C, honourable principal addressed the students about the significance of transactional skills.

This year the transactional skills is conducted online. Because of covid-19 which was successfully completed with all the cooperation, collaboration of both lecturers and students. The lecturers conducted the session as per the timetable and also gave demonstration lesson (6min) for each stage in all subjects. And also teacher trainees were asked to write lesson plan and give 6 min. presentation by using necessary teaching learning resources with all the components. Peace Day Celebration : 30/01/2021
















Women's Day Celebration – 8th March 2021







Online Classes : From April 2021









- The classes were interactive mode followed by discussions, seminar presentations, ppt presentations from students.







Open Book Examination : 24/05/2021 to 28/05/2021








1st & 2nd Preparatory Examination : 10/06/2021 to 15/06/2021 & 09/07/2021 to 15/07/2021






During the Lockdown period, our staff and students have attended webinars to enrich their knowledge and skills. They have actively participated and received E Certificate also.


